Always speak up and question if something is, or appears to be wrong

Avoid direct contact with cytotoxic and radiation drugs when planning pregnancy or during pregnancy

Provide information to patients & their significant others and encourage them to take an active part in their care

Always follow safety precautions; use personal protective equipment

SAFETY – The Key Points

Recent improved cancer treatment outcomes also carry with them new patient safety risks.

Cancer nurses' knowledge and actions are of great importance and reduce these risks.

Cancer nurses need to take action to protect themselves from the known risks involved in handling cytotoxic drugs.

Organisations need to support their cancer nurses and focus more on both occupational and patient safety.
